A look on QA from the BWSE2020

- **Berlin Communiqué** stated in 2003 that the quality of HE has proven to be at the heart of the setting up of EHEA and the QA is one of the fundamental priorities
- A milestone for creating a common language of QA around EHEA: ESGs
- Yerevan Communiqué from 2015 empowered a multipurpose
 QA by underlining its roles in learning and teaching
- Paris Communiqué from 2018 reiterated that QA is key in developing mutual trust as well as increasing mobility and fair recognition of qualifications and study periods throughout the EHEA

Collaboration is the key

- Students are not corrective factors, but insightful collaborators
- Criticism for the intent of improvement, not downgrading!



Preparation leads to perfection

- Students need to prepare for a particular review- give them some time
- Have in mind that the students are an important group for collecting institutional feedback- do not be afraid to ask "hard" questions
- Sometimes students are the most prepared panel members!?

Equal rights= equal commitment

- Students NEED to be equal to other panel members in all aspects
- Do not allow students to "sit and comment" on the evaluation process. Actively engage them!
